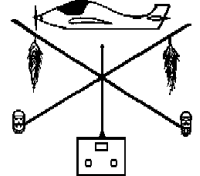

You're invited to join us for Saturday morning practice flying in the large Centennial Hall at Lakeshore Technical College in Cleveland. It's free/no charge! Bring your kids, your spouse, your neighbors, and have some indoor flying fun. You'll meet members from other local AMA clubs as well.

LTC is located one block east of I-43 (Mile Marker 137) Drive east on North Avenue and use the East Entrance Parking Lot. Drive to the north of the lot and look for the L8 Entrance banner. Go downstairs and turn right. You'll find tables and chairs along the walls and a carpeted runway. Planes or Drones must weigh less than 12 ounces. Pilots should bring their current AMA membership card. Kids are encouraged to come, watch and ask about this sport and even participate. There are plenty of outlets along the walls for recharging batteries. The ceiling is standard gym height. There's a student lounge with vending machines in an adjacent room. Come and have some fun!!
