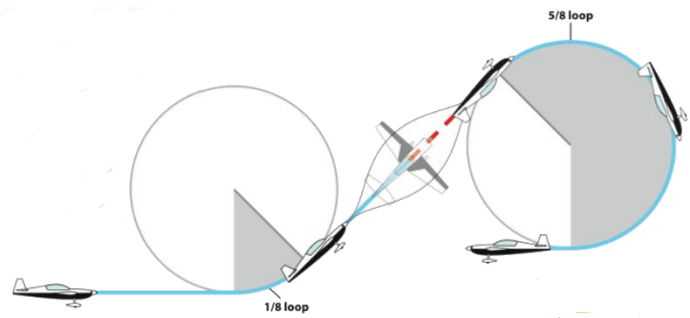


# NEWIS IMAC Challenge, July 21-22, 2018
