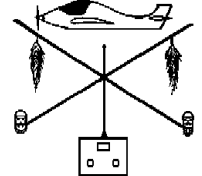

The Lake County Modelers and Flyers are presenting the following 2018 Events:



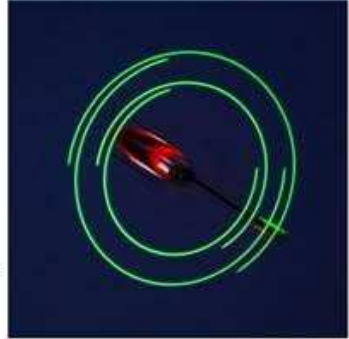
Michigan Jet Rally - June 7 - 9

This event is for jet pilots and spectators. There will be almost non-stop jet flying with over 25 jet pilots typically attending. Typically there are about 50+ jets brought to the event. These pilots come from all over the mid-west US of A and are the "Top Gun" of RC modeling.



West Michigan RC Expo - July 12 - 14

This event is for all RC pilots and spectators. There will be non-stop flying with over 40 pilots typically attending with over a hundred planes and helicopters. There are drone demonstrations and racing. There will be some model building and flight training for the Kids, Dad and Mom. We can have you flying in minutes. Our RC Flight Simulators will be available to all. Come give it a try with zero risk! We also have the car track open and manned with RC cars for the kids and dads. We have several cars. You bring the kids to operate them. Night Flying on Friday night.
