Minutes from the December 10, 2018 Meeting.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00. 11 members were in attendance.

Minutes from the November meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report for November was given and approved. November expenses were utilities, septic, and postage. December bills are newsletter expenses, utilities, field maintenance expenses, and property taxes. Motion passed to pay the bills.

OLD BUSINESS

Further discussion on the auction and raffle expenses was held, but no decision was made at this meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion passed to compensate Leon for his field maintenance services for the year.

Motion passed to allow the local snowmobile club to use the north end of the property for a trail. This would be well north of the mowed flying area.

There are issues with the current Calumet Flyers Constitution and Bylaws. The current dues structure does not meet the expenses for the club and the term limits as stated in the document are not being adhered to. It was proposed that this would be further discussed at the January meeting and a vote would be taken to amend the document. The changes proposed would eliminate the term limits for officer participation and allow for an annual vote on the dues structure. No further changes were proposed but additional items could be brought up at the January meeting for discussion.
